

Witness at the Cross;
A Beginner's Guide to Holy Friday
Lent - 2022

Rather than focusing exclusively on Jesus, these gatherings will invite us to consider anew the significance of the crucifixion through the eyes and ears of those who watched it happen and heard what was said by Jesus and those around him. When we consider Jesus' death from these people's unique and diverse points of view, we may well discover it means not less, but more than we as Christians often consider. We will find that each Gospel has its own story to tell, all the witnesses to the crucifixion have their own memories, and our prayer is that every participant in these faith formation gatherings will be transformed by new insights.

Each of the two gatherings will be limited to 12 to 14 participants and additional day/time options will be possible if the two classes are filled to capacity. If Board approved Covid protocols are amended, an in-person gathering may be offered.

There will be seven sessions, each will be a self-contained unit, so you do not have to commit to all seven.
