


Community Prayer Vigil for the People of Ukraine

Wednesday, September 14, 2022 Seven Lakes Chapel in the Pines 10:00 am–1:00 pm



Give ear, O Lord, to my prayer; listen to my cry of supplication. In the day of my trouble I call on you, for you will answer me. Psalm 86:6-7

In that we believe that God hears the prayers of the faithful and responds out of God's steadfast love and mercy to our pleas, we welcome you to this community prayer vigil for the people of Ukraine. Today we come together to pray for those suffering the death and destruction of war inside Ukraine and for all of the displaced Ukrainian refugees forced outside their country. We also lift up in prayer the people of Russia, especially those who are risking their lives to protest this war. And, we come together to pray for wisdom and strength for the leaders of all the nations trying to bring an end to the fighting so that a lasting and peaceful reconciliation between nations might become possible. Finally, we pray that you, O Lord, will transform the heart of President Vladimir Putin and show him the way of peace.



Surrounded by the beauty of this sanctuary we welcome you to this sacred place and invite you to stay as long as you would like in prayer and meditation. There will be no formal service, only the silence and space to be in God's presence and seek God's help and comfort for everyone caught up in the violence...Russians and Ukrainians.



As a community of believers may our prayers not cease as we leave this place, but continue until the hostilities end and a lasting peace is restored for the people of Ukraine.
