
Community Prayer Vigil for the People of Ukraine

Wednesday, October 19, 2022 Seven Lakes Chapel in the Pines 10:00 am—1:00 pm



Give ear, O Lord, to my prayer; listen to my cry of supplication. In the day of my trouble I call on you, for you will answer me. Psalm 86:6-7

In that we believe that God hears the prayers of the faithful and responds out of God's steadfast love and mercy to our pleas, we welcome you to this community prayer vigil for the people of Ukraine. Today we come together to pray for those suffering the death and destruction of war inside Ukraine and for all of the displaced Ukrainian refugees forced outside their country. We also lift up in prayer the people of Russia, especially those who are risking their lives to protest this war. And, we come together to pray for wisdom and strength for the leaders of all the nations trying to bring an end to the fighting so that a lasting and peaceful reconciliation between nations might become possible. Finally, we pray that you, O Lord, will transform the heart of President Vladimir Putin and show him the way of peace.

PR&JECT HOPE


Medicine, medical supplies and equipment, hygiene supplies, infant supplies, mental health and psychological support...this organization is working with people inside Ukraine.
