The Angels of Christmas; Hearing God's Voice in Advent Advent Afternoons - 2022



The Angels of Christmas; Hearing God's Voice in Advent is a four part Bible study that explores the angelic visits surrounding the birth of Jesus to Zechariah, Mary, Joseph, and the shepherds. We will attempt to bring our attention during Advent back to the central role of angels as messengers of good news whose words demand a response...whether from those who witnessed them in Old Testament days, encountered them before Jesus' birth two thousand years ago, or those of us who experience them today.

Session #1 - Sunday afternoon, November 27th Standing in the Presence of God; Gabriel and Zachariah

Session #2 - Sunday afternoon, December 4th Let It Be; Gabriel and Mary

Session #3 - Sunday afternoon, December 11th Acting on the Unbelievable; And Angel of the Lord and Joseph

Session #4 - Sunday afternoon, December 18th Hark the Herald Angels Sing; The Angels and the Shepherds

(As a bonus we will be showing two movies during Advent to which we will also invite the entire congregation...*It's a Wonderful Life* and *The Bishop's Wife*, both of which have angels as main characters (Clarence and Dudley).

If the numbers of participants work out we will have two different sessions, one online and one in-person. As you consider your participation please remember that the only way we may have a class for people who can only attend online is if we have enough who are flexible to participate in-person or online. The times of the classes will be determined as soon as we know the number of participants and whether we will have enough for one class or two.
