

The Parables of Matthew 13...

He put before them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed that someone took and sowed in his field; it is the smallest of all the seeds, but when it has grown it is the greatest of shrubs and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and make nests in its branches."





Kingdom Stewardship;

A Bible Study in Four Parts

This year during Stewardship Season here at the Chapel we will embark on a four-part Bible study that will broaden our perspective on stewardship. Let's be honest about the need to give of our resources to further the ministries of this chapel that we all love so much, but let's also consider that the concept of stewardship should be foremost in all areas of our lives. Let's imagine that this holistic approach to stewardship is that for which we were created by God and it's what will ultimately bring all of us the deepest sense of purpose, fulfillment, and blessing.

Each lesson is self-contained so it is not essential that you attend every session. There is no book to purchase. We will enjoy a short DVD presentation by the author of *King-dom Stewardship*, focus on the biblical basis for his comments, followed by a time of discussion. Each session should last about 60 minutes.
