**August 15th—September 5th**

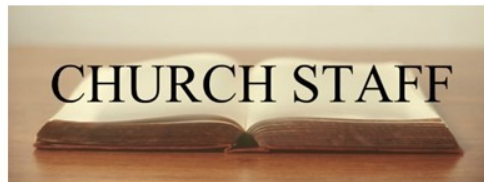
