

We will walk through the Bible's earliest source for the life of Jesus with New Testament scholar Amy-Jill Levine as she examines John the Baptizer, the little Apocalypse, the Transfiguration, and several of Jesus' most notable stories and parables. The good news of the gospel message comes alive in this book/study as readers see Jesus as divine and human, powerful and weak, approachable yet mysterious.


